Delegational system

## Maximum number, in case of 36 teams (with a 440 cm water depth):

Group ,,A" (Hungary):
8-24 teams, depending ont he number of competitors from groups „B"-,"E"
Group ,B" (Romania, Bulgaria, Greece, Turkey, Cyprus):

- In case of one participating country: a maximum of 6 teams,
- In case of two participating countries: a maximum of 8 teams,
- In case of three or more participating countries: a maximum of 10 teams.


## Group „, C" (Serbia, Macedonia, Montenegro, Bosnia \& Hercegovina, Kosovo, Croatia, Slovenia, Albania):

- In case of one participating country: a maximum of 2 teams,
- In case of two participating countries: a maximum of 4 teams,
- In case of three or more participating countries: a maximum of 7 teams.

Group ,D" (Austria, Switzerland, Germany, Italy and other countries not mentioned in groups $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}, \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{E}$ )

- In case of one participating country: a maximum of 2 teams,
- In case of two participating countries: a maximum of 4 teams,
- In case of three or more participating countries: a maximum of 6 teams.


## Group „E" (Slovakia, Czechia, Poland, Ukraine, Moldova, Russia and other East-European countries)

- In case of one participating country: a maximum of 2 teams,
- In case of two participating countries: a maximum of 4 teams,
- In case of three or more participating countries: a maximum of 5 teams.

In case of a lower base participant number, the group numbers will be modified proportionally. The BSHE reserves the right to accept applications from outside of Europe, at the expense of group „A".

## For your reference:

The delegational groups have been set up according to the results of the Ist-XVth Maconka International Boilie Cups. The international quotas will be revised every year, based on the results reached in the year of the competition. The teams noted in the rules by name, the ones chosen by the organizers, the ones that have applied on previous events and the teams representing new countries will take precedence during the judging of the applications.
